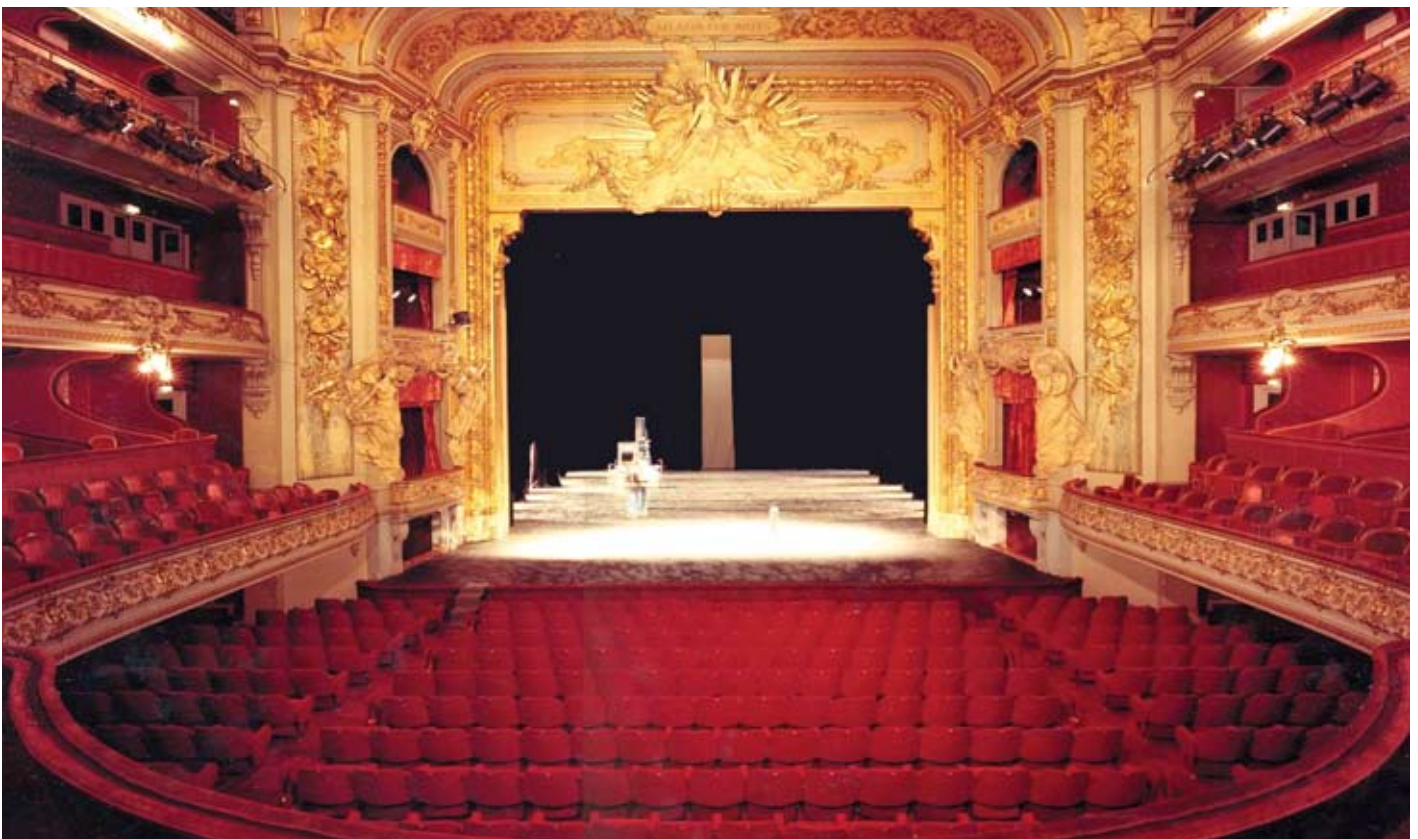

Opera Weekend

Reopened in December 2003 after six years of restoration, the interior of Lille Opera House contains a monumental staircase and sumptuous décor in the style of Louis XVI made of marble, stucco, bronze, gold and sparkling crystals. The Italian-style auditorium is one of the last examples built in France and can hold up to 1136 spectators. 2004 saw the Flemish city of Lille take the title of Cultural Capital of Europe. It is easy to see why. The Palais des Beaux Arts is one of France's finest museums outside Paris and has paintings by van Dyck, Rubens, Goya as well as an impressive display of French, Italian and Spanish works. The old city centre of Lille is full of 17th century Flemish buildings where you can wander the cobbled streets or, on Sunday morning, visit the buzzing Wazemmes flea and flower market.
